4.1 GGOS Unified Analysis Workshop, Follow-Up Meeting

The first GGOS Unified Analysis Workshop (UAW) took place in Monterey, California, USA, from December 6 to 8, 2007 (see report in Section 4.2 of the IERS Annual Report 2007). The scope of the workshop was to support one of the important goals of GGOS, which is to advance the combination and integration of the various space and in-situ geodetic techniques. To make a review of the status of work, a Follow-Up Meeting was organized at the Technical University of Vienna, Austria, on April 15, 2008.

At the beginning of the meeting, Markus Rothacher reviewed the status of the Action Items from the first UAW. Proposals for SINEX file name conventions and for the SINEX meta data block were presented by Axel Nothnagel and Bernd Richter, respectively. Markus Rothacher explained the final details of SINEX V2.20 with respect to extended parameterization. Johannes Böhm set out a proposal by him and Harald Schuh concerning reference pressure for GGOS.
